# A BILL

FOR

## An Act to amend the Census and Statistics Act 1905

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

### Short title, &c.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Census and Statistics Amendment Act 1985.

(2) The Census and Statistics Act  $1905^{1}$  is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section 1 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:

## **Application to external Territories**

"2. This Act, other than Part III, extends to such external Territories as are prescribed.".

#### Refusal or failure to answer questions, &c.

3. Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-section (2) and substituting the following sub-section:

"(2) Sub-section (1) does not apply in relation to a refusal or failure by a person to answer a question, or to supply particulars, relating to the person's religious beliefs.".
