# A BILL

**FOR** 

### An Act to amend the Ministers of State Act 1952

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

#### Short title, &c.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Amendment Act 1985.
  - (2) The *Ministers of State Act 1952*<sup>1</sup> is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

#### Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### Salaries of Ministers

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "\$610,000" and substituting "\$630,000".
