A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Representation Act 1983*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title, &c.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Representation Amendment Act 1985*.

5 (2) The *Representation Act 1983*¹ is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

10 **Transitional provision—increase in size of the Senate**

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-section (6) “the day referred to in sub-section (1)” and substituting “1 December 1984”.
